Mid-South Leadership Council Forum Follow Up

NAPEO hosted the Mid-South Leadership Council Forum on March 28 in New Orleans, Louisiana. More than 20 people gathered to discuss issues impacting PEOs doing business in the region. Rufus Wolff, Principal at Wolff & Ward, provided an employment law update. Attendees then heard from Tommy Fonseca from Greater New Orleans Inc. who talked about the area's economy, segments of industry that are growing and efforts to innovate and build infrastructure.

Louisiana State Representative Kirk Talbot (R-District 78), who serves as Chairman of the House Insurance Committee, talked about a gross receipts tax proposal the Governor is expected to unveil, the state of Louisiana's budget and priorities for the 2017 legislative session. Robert Wooley, NAPEO's contract lobbyist, discussed Louisiana's political landscape. The group then talked about the Louisiana bill NAPEO is to put forward making corrections to the PEO statute and the industry's issues with the Board of Contractors with issuance of workers' compensation coverage. NAPEO provided a federal update on the status of the CPEO program and federal priorities during the new Trump Administration.
